#### If you currently receive SNAP:

You will be notified about the status of your November SNAP benefits by the NYS Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) through the <u>OTDA website</u>, <u>NYC ACCESS HRA</u>, <u>myBenefits</u>, the ebtEDGE app, and by text. Any unused benefits will remain available after November 1—you can check your EBT balance at <u>ebtEDGE.com</u> or through the app. Continue completing required steps like recertifications and periodic reports to stay eligible.

Are there any restrictions on using my SNAP benefits during the federal government shutdown? No, your EBT card will work as usual, and you can use your SNAP benefits at all authorized retailers and farmers markets. You can check your balance by:

- Looking at your last receipt.
- Calling the customer service helpline at 1-888-328-6399.
- Checking your EBT account online at <u>www.ebtEDGE.com</u>.
- Using the ebtEDGE mobile app.

Will my EBT card still work in November? Based on information available to OTDA, your EBT card will still work in November. Unused SNAP benefits received previously will still be available. The Public Assistance program will continue to operate as usual.

Can I apply for SNAP during the federal government shutdown if I do not already receive benefits? Yes. Applications for SNAP will continue to be accepted. However, if you are approved for SNAP during the federal government shutdown, you may not receive benefits until the shutdown ends. You can apply for SNAP online at <a href="maybenefits">myBenefits</a>, in person at your local SNAP office, or by mail.

**Do I still have to meet SNAP requirements during the federal government shutdown?** Yes, you still need to follow all SNAP rules, like completing your recertification, submitting reports, and informing your local SNAP office of certain changes in your household's circumstances.

What if I need to recertify for SNAP and have not yet submitted my recertification application? It is important to submit your recertification application as soon as possible. SNAP participants must continue to meet program requirements to remain eligible for benefits. You can submit your recertification online at <u>myBenefits</u>, in person or by mail.
